Bremer Bay Fisheries Beach Marina update:

Works are underway to replace the boat ramps and jetty and we have received confirmation from the contractor that the boat launching facilities will be closed from this coming Monday 4 of April 2022 until further notice.

The new longer and improved boat ramps and jetty are scheduled to be reopened in July. We thank everyone for their patience and understanding during this time.

Moorshead Road, Jerramungup:

Reconstruction works are continuing on the section of Moorshead Road

between Vasey Street and Tobruk Road. The road remains closed to ensure the bitumen is able to fully dry and to allow kerbing works to be completed. We anticipate it will be reopened on Friday 1 April 2022 dependant on weather conditions.

JERRAMUNGUP POOL UPDATE

With great excitement we are looking forward to the end of April, when construction on the new Community Pool is expected to be completed and the site handed back over to us from the contractor.

As you can see in these photos tiling has been completed on the main pool as well as the toddler's pool. The plant room and toilet/change rooms are taking shape and the retaining wall works have been completed.

With most of the heavy lifting done, Marawar is now focusing on finishing off the site and amenity rooms. The look ahead for the next couple of weeks will see a lot of progress including a concrete apron around the pool, the artificial turf being installed, the waterbodies filled with water, the perimeter fence and shade



sails installed and more work being completed to finish off the plant room and ablutions.

Once on the final stretch, we are required to obtain all approvals from the Department of Education, Department of Health and our Environmental Health Services, before we can officially commission the pool and bring it back into action.

This project has had a lot of challenges (unforeseen site conditions, floods, fires, material and contractor



shortages as a result of Covid19) and has therefore taken longer to complete than initially expected.

We would therefore like to give a big thank you to our community for being so patient and understanding and giving us the time to ensure the works are completed right which will allow the pool to be enjoyed for a long time in the future.

HAZARD REDUCTION ACTIVITIES – BREMER BAY TOWNSITE

Residents and visitors of Bremer Bay are advised that volunteers and staff from Bremer Bay VFES, Jerramungup BFB's and Shire of Jerramungup will be conducting Hazard Reduction Burns in the Bremer Bay town site over a 6 week period.

PURPOSE: To commence with the establishment of a low fuel buffer zone around the Bremer Bay town site to

reduce the potential for a bushfire impacting the town site.

Prescribed burning will be undertaken with consideration of winds to minimise smoke from

entering town site.

DATE: Beginning Monday, 21st March 2022 (Autumn equinox) for a period of approximately 6 weeks.

LOCATION: Areas of the Bremer Bay town site and fire management access tracks as per the map below:



Planned Prescribed Burns Bremer Bay Town Site 2022

WHAT TO DO DURING AND AFTER HAZARD REDUCTION ACTIVITIES:

- Traffic speed restrictions of 40kph will apply with traffic management signs installed on day of the burns.
- Road closures may also be in place on the day of burning activities for the safety of Fire Fighters operating within the area.
- Motorists are asked to have their headlights on when driving through the area and drive to the conditions as the smoke hazard may remain for a number of days after the burn is completed.

- Abide by all directions of Fire Fighters/Emergency Services personnel on scene.
- Smoke may affect visibility and air quality in and around Bremer Bay on the day itself and the days following. Residents and visitors with any respiratory conditions are reminded to have their medication close by or on them as a precaution.
- Fire Fighters will be conducting patrols of the treatment areas in the days following each prescribed burn.
