








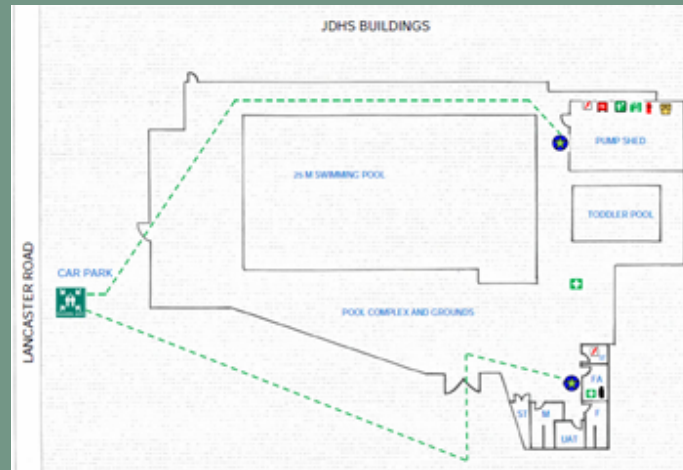


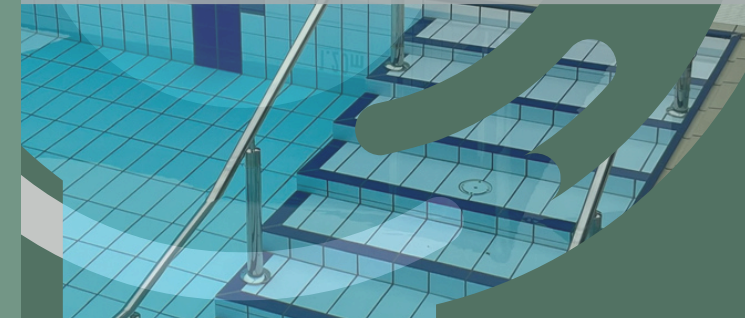

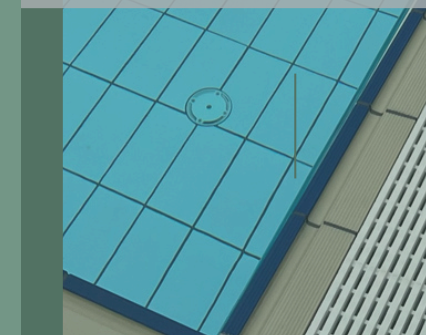

## KEY HOLDER INFORMATION

The Shire of Jerramungup is pleased to welcome all community members to utilise the Swimming Pool for the 2024/2025 season, with the pool opening for use from Monday, 14 October 2024.

**As there is NO lifeguard on-duty at this facility, to ensure your safety under the Aquatic Facilities Code of Practice (Department of Health), the Shire requires all Key Holders to complete a Pool Induction Course which is valid for 3 years.**

Those wishing to attend a Pool Induction Course must register with the Shire and you will be placed on a list for the next available course.

To register, please email [admin@jerramungup.wa.gov.au](mailto:admin@jerramungup.wa.gov.au) or call the Shire on 9835 1022. You will need to bring along your bathers as it is a requirement to demonstrate that you can swim the length of the pool (25 meters).

## CONDITIONS OF USE POOL RULES

- CHILDREN UNDER 16YEARS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY 1 ADULT (≥18YRS);
- CHILDREN UNDER 16YEARS MUST BE UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION OF AN ADULT ≥ 18YEARS, WHO IS PREPARED TO ENTER THE WATER AND IS MAINTAINING CONSTANT SURVEILLANCE OF THE POOL AND CHILD SWIMMERS THAT THEY HAVE BROUGHT TO THE POOL (I.E. NOT LEFT WHILE SWIMMING LAPS OR READING A BOOK).
- CHILDREN WHO ARE >16YEARS MAY USE THE POOL ALONE UNDER THEIR PARENTS' USER AGREEMENT IF THEY PRODUCE A COPY OF THEIR BRONZE MEDALLION CERTIFICATE TO THE SHIRE. (UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CAN THIS PERSON BRING IN OTHER USERS OR SUPERVISE CHILDREN)
- THERE MAY BE NO DIVING INTO THE POOL AT THE SHALLOW END.
- SMOKING AND THE CONSUMPTION OF DRUGS AND OR ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA.
- USER MUST MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO ENSURE FAMILY PICNICS, AND OTHER ACTIVITIES DO NOT COMPROMISE PARENTAL SUPERVISION.
- NO DIVE BOMBING, RUNNING OR ROUGH PLAY IS ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR POOL AREA.
- SURFBOARDS, LIE LOWS AND OTHER LARGE FLOTATION DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE POOL OR POOL AREA.
- ALL TOYS AND OBJECTS MUST BE REMOVED AFTER EACH USE AT THE POOL.
- ANIMALS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA (DISABILITY COMPANIONS ARE PERMITTED.)
- DRINKING GLASSES AND GLASS BOTTLES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA.
- A PERSON MUST NOT ENTER OR USE, OR ATTEMPT TO ENTER OR USE, THE POOL FACILITIES IF A PERSON IS;
  - SUFFERING FROM ANY GASTROINTESTINAL DISEASE, SKIN INFECTION OR OTHER DISEASE THAT IS TRANSMITTABLE IN AN AQUATIC ENVIRONMENT; OR
  - IN AN UNCLEAN CONDITION; OR
  - WEARING UNCLEAN CLOTHES; OR
  - UNDER THE APPARENT INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.
- BABIES, CHILDREN AND PERSONS SUFFERING INCONTINENCE AND WHO ORDINARILY WEAR NAPPIES MUST WEAR AN AQUA-NAPPY IN THE WATER.
